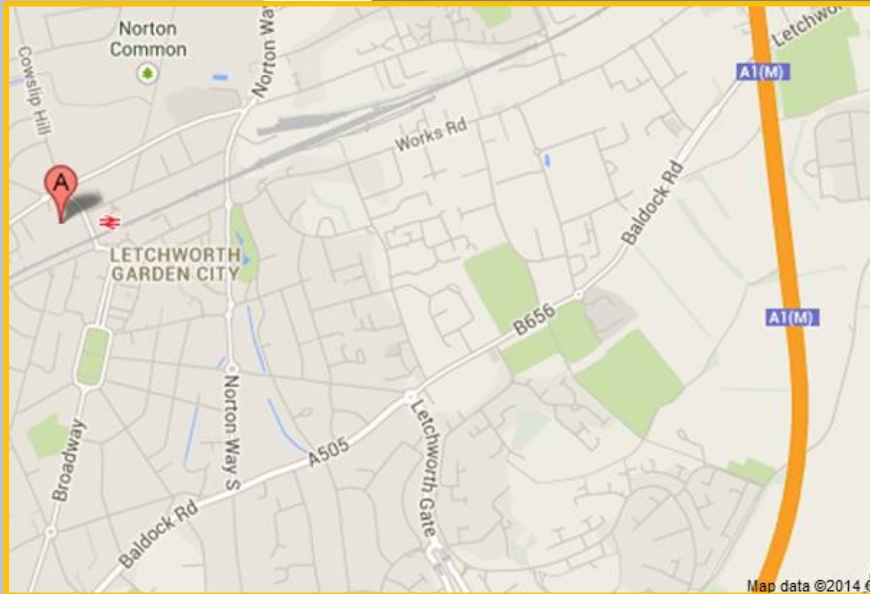

By Walking

Letchworth Garden City railway station is located 0.2 miles from our offices, an easy 5 minutes' walk. Pedestrian can access the building from Bridge Road, a 2 minutes' walk from the bus stops on station place



By Bicycle

Bicycle racks are provided. Those who cycle to work can claim reimbursement for their cycle mileage at a rate of 20p per mile here.

To encourage staff members to choose active modes of transport, we have introduced the Bike4Work scheme, which reduces the cost of buying bicycle related safety equipment. Services run up to every 10 to 15 minutes during peak times. Letchworth Garden City Railway Station is part of the First Capital Connect Railway network. Services to the North via Peterborough and East Anglia via Cambridge are within easy reach of the Garden City.

By Car/Vehicle

Our offices are under 30 minutes' drive from junction 23 of the M25 and 10 minutes from junction 9 and 10 of the A1 (M) (Refer to location map).

We're also just a 20-minutes' drive from Luton and Junction 10 of the M1, via the A505.

Car sharing – if driving is completely necessary please consider car sharing, where possible, with somebody who might be going to the same location. This is of benefit to the business and you as it leads to reduced fuel spend, reduced vehicle wear and tear and reduced carbon emissions. In addition, those who car share can claim reimbursement for their mileage at a rate of 5p for that part of the journey.
